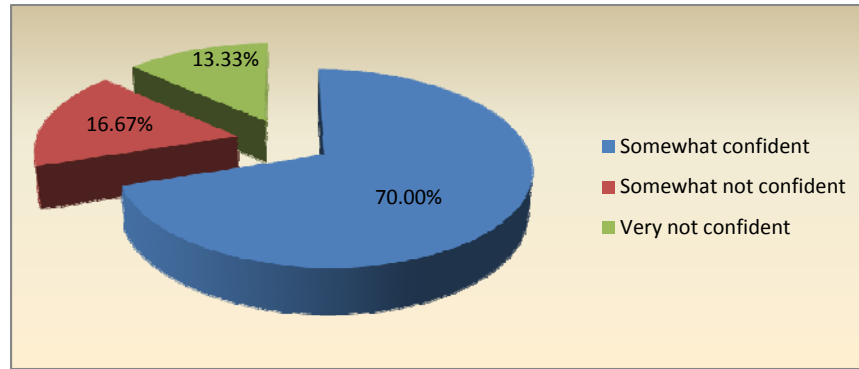


Turning Graphical Results by Question

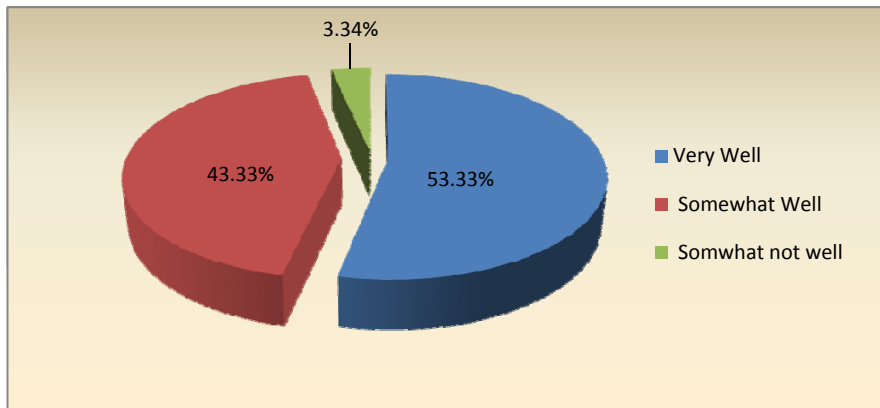
1.) How confident are you that evidence-based practices will be effectively implemented statewide in Nebraska?

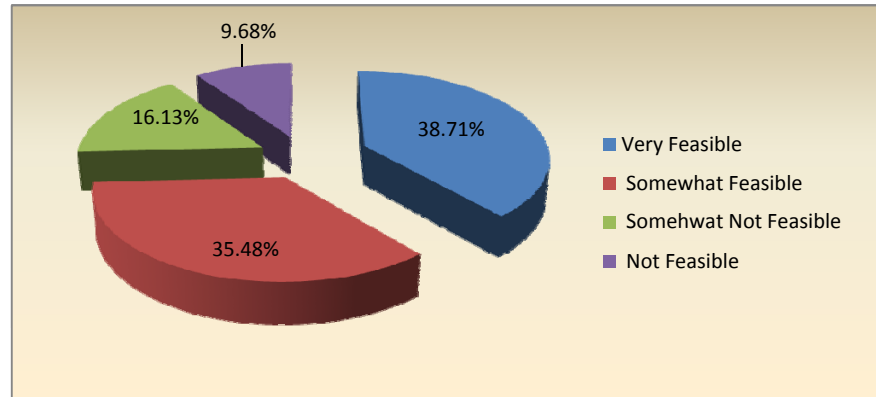
2.) How well do you understand the concepts of evidence-based practices?

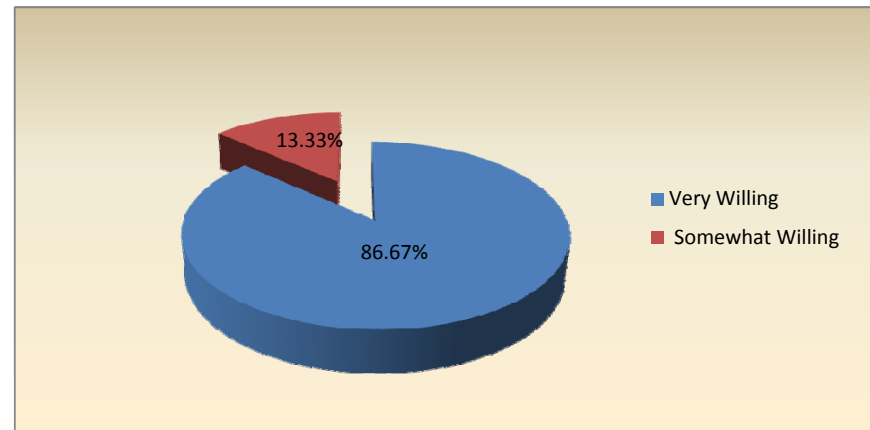
3.) How feasible do you believe collaboration is among state government, researchers, and practitioners to promote evidence-based practices across Nebraska?

4.) How willing are you personally to continue collaborating to effectively implement evidence-based practices in Nebraska?

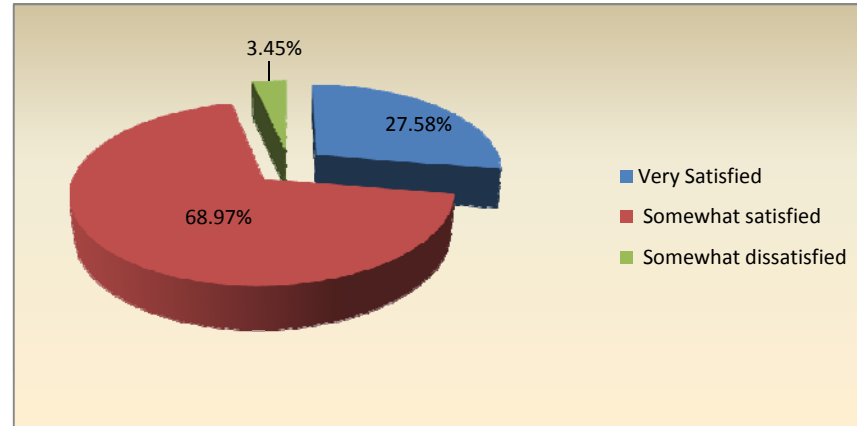
